



# HOW TO RECITE THE CHAPLET



The Chaplet of Mercy is recited using ordinary rosary beads of five decades. The Chaplet is preceded by two opening prayers from the Diary of Saint Faustina and followed by a closing prayer.

### 1. Make the Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen. +'I he Huafa 'o e Tamai mo e 'Alo mo e Laumalie Ma'oni'oni. 'Ameni.

#### 2. Optional Opening Prayers

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us. (Repeat three times)

- +O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!
- + 'A e Ta'ata'a mo e Vai na'e tafe mei he Mafu 'o Sesu ko e matavai 'o e Faimanava'ofa mo'o kimautolu, 'Oku ou Falala atu kiate Koe. (x3)
- ++ JESUS I TRUST IN YOU ++
- ++ SESU 'OKU OU FALALA ATU KIATE KOE ++

#### 3. Our Father

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, **Amen.** 

+ 'Ei 'emau Tamai 'oku 'i Hevani ke tapuha ho huafa ke hoko mai ho Pule'anga ke fai ho finangalo 'i mamani 'o hange ko ia 'i Hevani. Foaki mai he 'aho ni ha'amau me'akai faka'aho pea ke fakamolemole'i 'emau ngaahi angahla 'o hange ko 'emau fakamolemole 'a kinautolu 'oku fai hala mai kiate kimautolu, pea 'oua na'a ke tuku kimautolu kemau hinga ki ha fakatauele ka ke fakahaofi kimautolu mei he kovi. 'Ameni.

#### 4. Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death, **Amen.** +Si'oto'ofa Malia 'oku ke mohu he Kalasia 'oku 'iate Koe 'a e 'Eiki, 'oku ke monu'ia ko e 'i he fefine fua pe, pea 'oku faitapuekina 'a e fua ho manava ko Sesu. +Sangata Malia ko e fa'e 'a e 'Otua ke ke hufia kimautolu angahala 'i he 'aho ni pea mo e 'aho foki 'emau mate. '**Ameni.** 

## 5. The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. **Amen.** 

#### + LOTU TUI 'A E KAU 'APOSETOLO

'Oku ou tui ki he 'Otua ko e Tamai Māfimafi, 'a ē na'a ne fakatupu 'a e langí mo māmaní. Pea 'oku ou tui kia Sēsū Kilisitō, ko hono 'Alo pē 'e taha, ko hotau 'Eikí; 'a ē na'e tupu-tangata 'i he ngāue pē 'a e Laumālie Mā'oni'oní, pea 'alo'i ia 'e he Tāupo'ou ko Malia, pea ne mamahi ia 'i he pule 'a Ponitō Pailato, na'e kalusefai foki ia 'o pekia, pea telio, pea hā'ele hifo ia ki he kau mate, pea tu'u ia 'i hono 'aho tolu meí he pekia, pea hā'ele hake ia ki Hevani, 'o 'afio 'i he to'omata'u 'o e 'Otua ko e Tamai Māfimafi, pea 'e toki hā'ele mai mei ai, ke Fakamāu'i 'a e mo'ui mo e mate. Pea 'oku ou tui foki ki he Laumālie Mā'oni'oní, mo e Sangata 'Ekelesia Katolika, mo e feohi 'a e kakai angatonu, mo e fakamolemole 'o e angahala, mo e tu'u hake 'a e sino pea mo e mo'ui ta'engata. 'Ameni.





# THE ROSARY

#### 6. The Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

• 'E Tamai ta'engata 'oku ou momoi hake ni kiate Koe 'a e Sino mo e Ta'ata'a, Laumalie mo e 'Otua 'o ho 'Alo 'Ofeina ka ko homau fakamo'ui ko Sesu Kilisito, ke fakamolemole'i 'aki 'a 'emau ngaahi angahala mo e angahala kotoa 'a mamani.

### 7. On the 10 Small Beads of Each Decade

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

+ Tu'unga 'i he'ene mamahi mo 'ene Pekia. 'Alo'ofa mai kiate kimautolu pea mo Mamani katoa(x10)

## 8. Repeat for the remaining decades

Saying the "Eternal Father" (6) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (7) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

+ Same as abouve.

# 9. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

+ 'E 'Otua Ma'oni'oni, 'Otua Mafimafi, 'Otua Ta'engata, 'Alo'ofa mai kiate kimautolu pea mo mamani katoa.(x3)

## 10. Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.
